Structure of Letters: Not always in this order Greetings. 'To the angel of the church in..'

Titles of Christ: Usually taken from the Ch 1 descriptions

Affirmations: 'I know...'

Rebuke: Except Smyrna & Philadelphia

Warnings of what is coming & Instructions to repent or hold fast.

Exhortations. 'He who has an ear, let him hear...'

Promises 'To him who overcomes... (is victorious/faithful/endures) which can be tied back to the title used of Christ to that church.
